Niihama has a population of about 110,000. Situated between hills and the sea, Niihama is surrounded by nature.



The summer fireworks festival and the autumn Taiko festival are the major festivals to experience.

The Besshi Copper Mine is a famous industrial heritage site situated in the area.

Famous foods include Fuguzaku (ふぐざく), fried chicken (ざんき) and Shichifuku sweet potatoes (七福芋).

Things to do When You First Move to Niihama

■ <u>Move-In Procedures (Residence Registration)</u>

Complete the residence registration procedures within 14 days of arriving in Niihama.

Required documents — When moving from abroad

- ① Passport
- ② Residence card

- When moving from another city



- Moving-out certificate (転出証明書)
- ② Residence card
- ③ My Number Card (※If you have it)

The National Pension System covers everyone between the ages of 20 and 60 years old who live in Japan.

Taking Out the Garbage

In Niihama, wastes are classified into 10 categories. You must separate your garbage on the basis of these categories and then dispose it.

The items you have to throw away and the days you can throw them away depend on where you live.

Pamphlets with information on garbage disposal methods are available in different languages (Vietnamese, Portuguese, Malay, English, Korean, Chinese, Indonesian, Burmese and Easy Japanese).

When you go to the hospital, please bring your health insurance card or my number card (which has been registered to be used as a health insurance card) and money.

If you are not sure whether to call an ambulance or go to a hospital, call Ehime Emergency Telephone Consultation (#7119).

Traffic Rules

In Japan, pedestrians must walk on the right side of the road, while cars, motorbikes, and bicycles must drive on the left side of the road.

Pedestrians have priority on roads.

Driving while on phone or drunk driving are strictly prohibited.

During Emergencies and Disasters

During Emergencies

If there is a fire, illness, or injury that requires immediate medical attention and could be life-threatening, dial 119 and request an ambulance.

In case of an incident or accident, dial 110 and call the police.

During Heavy Rains

When a heavy rain warning is issued, there may be possibilities of landslides and floods.

Please do not go out unnecessarily, be prepared to evacuate, and evacuate to a safe place if necessary.

During an Earthquake

Earthquakes take place frequently in Japan.

It is important to be prepared for earthquakes at all times.

If an earthquake occurs, don't panic and protect your head.

Take shelter under a sturdy desk.

Do not go outside immediately.
